

Food Vendor Rules and Regulations

- 1. All vendors must be set up and have all vehicles removed from the festival area on Friday evening by 6 pm and Saturday morning by 8 am.
- 2. A copy of your current General and Product Liability Insurance policy with a minimum of \$500,000 limit.
- 3. A detailed menu of all the items you intend to serve. Any deviation from your menu will not be allowed. This is how food vendors will be selected.
- 4. A check made payable to the N C Rice Festival.
- 5. You are required to stay open all hours of the festival.
- 6. A menu with a price list must be posted and visible to the public.
- 7. All vendors must wear gloves while preparing and serving food. If gloves have been contaminated by touching anything other than food then gloves must be changed.
- 8. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their space.
- 9. All vendors must supply the proper fire extinguisher required by the Fire Marshal and have available on site at all times.
- 10. No food preparation is allowed until a permit is issued by the Health Department.
- 11. Grey water containers will be available for disposing waste water. No water is to be dumped on the ground including melting ice and hand washing runoff.
- 12. Grease container will be available and location will be given to all vendors in their packets.
- 13. Food vendors MUST submit a Temporary Food Establishment (TFE) Permit to the Brunswick County Health Department. They can be contacted at 910-253-2250. Food vendor is responsible for completing the form and sending in the correct amount of money by September 1, 2014

15. Non-profit groups applying must submit a copy of their 501 © (3) paperwork from the IRS.
